Pool Rules

General Rules:

- 1. All children under 8 years of age must be supervised by a person 14 years of age or older. Supervising person must supervise the child at all times, in and around the swimming pool.
- 2. No person shall be under the influence of drugs or alcohol while in the facility. Drugs and Alcohol are strictly prohibited.
- 3. Smoking or the use of smokeless tobacco is not permitted inside the facility.
- 4. Glass containers are not permitted.
- 5. Animals of any kind are not permitted, except for working dogs which must be clearly marked with the appropriate vest.
- 6. Abusive or inappropriate language will not be permitted at any time.
- 7. No running or rough play
- 8. RLERPD is NOT responsible for personal property
- 9. RLERPD reserves the right to limit admission due to safety considerations
- 10. Admission to the pool may be refused to any person having a contagious, infectious, or communicable disease; including open cuts, sores, wounds, etc. These guests will not be allowed in the pool.
- 11. No skateboards, rollerblades, bikes, or scooters are allowed inside the pool facility
- 12. Pool may close due to inclement weather
- 13. Conversations with lifeguards should be limited. Please direct any problems, concerns, or questions to the Pool Manager

Pool Rules:

- 1. No one will enter the pool unless a qualified lifeguard is on duty
- 2. Only proper swim attire will be permitted in the pool. No Jean shorts, under garments, or cutoffs will be allowed. No shorts with metal snaps or zippers will be allowed. T-shirts must be tucked in or tied at the waist
- 3. Children not potty trained must wear an appropriate swim diaper
- 4. Showers are required before entering the pool
- 5. No prolonged underwater swimming or breath holding
- 6. Spitting or spouting of water in the pool is strictly prohibited
- 7. Only U.S. Coast Guard approved personal safety flotation life vests are permitted in the pool. Life vests must fit properly, and the non-swimmer must always be within arms' reach of an adult.
- 8. No water wings, floaties, rafts, body boards, frisbees, water guns, or other inflatables are permitted in the pool
- 9. No snorkeling or scuba equipment is allowed
- 10. Flipping, throwing sitting on shoulders, piggyback rides, and other unsafe activities are not permitted
- 11. Holding, standing, or hanging on the pool rope, lane lines, or ladders is prohibited.
- 12. Use only the designated pool entrance/exit
- 13. No food, gum, or drinks permitted inside the pool
- 14. Lifeguards have the right to stop any play which they deem dangerous
- 15. Guests must obey lifeguards and aquatic staff instructions at all times. Failure to comply will result in dismissal from the facility.
